Funding In Action

Cultivate: Nourishing Connection & Confidence

One example of how your support translates into real community impact is Cultivate, our program that addresses persistent fundraising gaps that affect nonprofit leaders of color, and the organizations and communities they serve. The results are meaningful because connection and confidence are foundational to long-term success.

In the 2025 cohort, 100% of participants reported feeling connected to nonprofit peers by the end of the program, building networks that strengthen collaboration across the sector. Seventy-one percent increased their confidence as fundraisers, with many going on to double or even triple their fundraising expectations, unlocking new resources for their missions.

Community In Action

In 2025, you brought community-serving work to life through three Tour & Talks, hands-on volunteer experiences, and a year-end social that created space to learn, connect, and celebrate:

- At Woodland’s Center for Land-Based Learning, we explored efforts to address food insecurity, including the Foundation’s **multi-year \$1 million investment to nourish local families** — made possible through gifts to the Impact Fund.
- At Sacramento’s Improve Your Tomorrow, one of the organizations supported through **\$300,000 in recent awards for education and mental wellness**, we learned from mentors and students how these investments make a difference for young people and their families now and long into the future.
- We also rolled up our sleeves with Sutter Health volunteers at the Food Literacy Center, and later, visited Balanced Body to see how local businesses are investing in community health.
